Dear Concerned Parent,

If I am not mistaken, you are the parent of young children.

And that means we have both spent some sleepless nights praying, rocking, consoling, holding and hugging a little one.

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You and I both know that a parent doesn't have much influence over his or her kids while they're at school. Yes, we can discuss matters with our child, with the teacher, and get some feedback on how their day went - but we can't sit in the classroom every day. That is the domain of the teachers.

What is taught in the classroom very often affects the child for years - possibly, for life. I still remember positive remarks from grade school teachers I heard long ago, and you probably do as well. What is learned early and reinforced over and over again takes root in the mind and becomes "the way it is" in the child's thinking.

In our world today, the problem for parents can become complex: <u>Just what are your children learning in their school</u>, and does it agree with what you are teaching them in the home?

Can you be assured that the teachers in your child's school relate to how you have been bringing up your child at home? And even more importantly, do they reflect your ideals and world views? Can you rest assured that if your faith is strong in the home, everything your child is learning affirms and reflects that faith and its moral imperatives?

I am writing today to make one of your life's most challenging decisions very simple.

You see, there is a way to give your children the very best in education, and it fits in perfectly with what you teach at home. And it solves a host of other problems, eliminating most of your concerns as a parent.

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A Unique and Distinctive Education

Just imagine a school where class sizes are smaller, so that teachers get to know their students personally. And how that leads to the teacher's ability to understand each student's strengths, weaknesses, learning style and personality.

The Search For Something Missing

This is the story of Luke. . .told by Amy, his mom: "In preschool, my son, Luke, was so shy. In a group piano lesson, if a new student was added to the group, he wouldn't participate that day. He would miss snack time because he was so shy that he wouldn't speak up and ask for his snack. We were very concerned.

Originally, for kindergarten I was going to put him in the public school; we checked out many schools. He was so tender hearted and shy . . .and I didn't want to see him lost. We also debated whether to hold him back. So we said we'll put him in a private school, and if we hold him back, he won't even know he was held back - then we'll put him in the public school (because he's a May birthday.)

A Miracle? Or Could DGCS Just Be Part Of God's Plan?

"And so after looking at a couple of different schools, we found Downers Grove Christian School, and it was wonderful: There were only 5-6 kids in this afternoon kindergarten class, so I enrolled him -- and it was the greatest value I could ever find in an education for my son. With 6 kids in the class, it was almost like a private tutor, and the very first day I didn't even want to do the car line (to pick him up after school) because he was so shy. So I waited for him outside the classroom door, and I <u>could hear him talking</u>--it was the <u>first time</u> I ever heard him speak in any classroom environment. He just felt so secure here. And if you talk to anybody, he was the shyest child that was ever here.

"He would stand behind kids in the Christmas program - I wouldn't see him. But by third grade, he had a solo in the school play, and he's not a singer, but they gave him a solo. As the years went by, his confidence improved so much that he started being in all the plays. It was just a total turnaround in personality."

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A Whole New World Of True Freedom For Your Child

Amy Adds, "He's at Downers Grove North now. He's on the football team. He loves school; he has a ton of friends. He's the only football player that doesn't swear. He's starting a no-swear club; he's trying to get them all to stop, and they respect him. He said, "Everyone knows that I'm a Christian, and I have so many friends you can't believe it." And I believe it!

"This school's given him so much confidence; he's just turned into a man here, and he's so firm in his beliefs and values that he's not swayed by what he sees around him. If anything, he's telling the people around him, "Hey, don't do that - come to church with me; do this," and they respect him for it. Because he's not wishy-washy; he knows what he believes. He knows what's right and what isn't. I am just so amazed with that part of the school: it's changed him for the better.

"He went through so many awkward times and phases, but nobody ever teased him; nobody ever made fun of him. He played the flute and nobody ever teased him.

"I feel a great peace with my children there. The school has instilled confidence in my son and has trained him to be a true leader. I wondered about sending him to other schools, back when he was small, but DGCS was a place where I knew he would have quality of life and education. And I wanted it right then, not sometime in the future--so we enrolled him then and there. And we've never regretted it."

Enrollment Is Limited . . .

- Obviously, there are some who are not in a financial position to attend a private school although, to be truthful, it most often (but not always) comes down to a priority issue. We have some parents who have sacrificed extensively to ensure that their child has the best education and learning environment that life can offer.

Whatever the case may be, DGCS could unquestionably benefit <u>every</u> young child - but not everyone will feel that it is a "fit" for their child.

DGCS understands and sincerely respects those parents. And in the end, we defer to them to determine, after prayerfully considering everything here, what's best for their child.

But I believe that you are reading this letter because you feel that you and your child could be a part of those select few that qualify to enroll.

An Inside Look: What DGCS Will Do For Your Child

So let me give you a deeper look into Downers Grove Christian School:

Every day begins with prayer. **Prayer is the foundation** of our school. Prayer underscores our reliance upon the Living God and our trust in His Son, Jesus Christ - to guide and direct us (Proverbs 3:5), to impart wisdom (James 1:5), and to fill us with the knowledge of His will though all spiritual wisdom and understanding (Colossians 1:9).

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The foundation does three things. It helps the children to understand that God is and always will be first and foremost in their lives. He alone is the <u>Rock</u> upon which all truly successful lives are built.

Secondly, it allows God's Holy Spirit to interact with each student and teacher in the process of learning, understanding and growing in the faith - every single day.

Thirdly, true learning begins right there, at the prayer foundation. Students are co-laboring with and relying on God to answer them in their quest for knowledge, wisdom and truth. They also experience the answers to prayer, and understand with souldeep conviction the incredible power of prayer, and of this amazing God, who loves them unconditionally.

A Unique School And Teaching Model That Gives Your Child So Much

Next comes the actual teaching, and true learning follows. Our curriculum, environment and teaching model are unlike anything you will see in the public school system and many other private schools.

We teach and illustrate daily how God is intimately and actively involved in all of His creation, from the vast reaches of the Universe down to the smallest known atomic particle.

Whether the discipline is science or mathematics, history or creative writing, reading or language, physical education or music - our students gain a fuller understanding of the amazing complexity and orderliness of God's world. They will also gain a deeper awareness of the goodness and power of their Creator.

Whether the student is in our new gymnasium, learning that the body is the temple of the Holy Spirit, and how to develop that temple . . . or studying doctrine in the warm ambience and good company of his or her fellow students in the classroom . . .

We teach every student that he/she is a "one-off," totally unique masterpiece (Ephesians 2:10), created in God's image and entrusted to parents who, in turn, entrust their masterpieces to us at DGCS.

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How Does This Teaching Method Work? Is It Really Unique?

Well, maybe we should refer to it as the "Four Rs." That is to say our teaching methodology employs four, interrelated components:

- Research Now who is more inquisitive than a young child? Students from Preschool 3 to 8th grade are taught to seek answers to their myriad questions. They are taught these skills from their earliest years here, which are progressively honed and expanded upon. This results in a powerful advantage in every area of their lives at every turn, because they are living the Scriptural guarantee, "Ask, and you will receive; seek, and you will find; knock, and the door will be opened." (Matthew 7:7)
- Reasoning This is the "how" of learning. True reasoning is either deductive (theory-hypothesisobservation-confirmation), or inductive (observationpattern-tentative hypothesis-theory); and on a daily basis, the student is taught the use of each. Because life is about practical outcomes and solutions, the student's mind comes alive and understanding grows consistently.
- Relating What is arrived at by reasoning is applied Scripturally and practically in the daily life of the student. He or she learns how God's truth fits in with what is being researched, studied and reasoned. The effective application of relating in the curriculum and in everyday life becomes clearly and indelibly imprinted in the mind, and is used effectively as the student develops.
- Revelation God's word, the Bible, is His love letter to mankind, His instruction manual for living, and His revelation to us. At the core of our curriculum is our reliance upon Scripture to inspire, teach, correct, explain, assist and empower the student. God has spoken to every man, woman and child on Planet Earth, and His crucial outline for all of life is woven into every teaching lesson and subject in our school. As the student progresses, the Hand and wisdom of God, the Master Teacher, is revealed.

As you can tell, the way we teach our students at DGCS is not rote learning - mere absorption of facts and data, followed by mindless repetition. As you've read, learning is accomplished through a unique combination of Research, Reasoning, Relating, and Revelation. The difference is vast, and so are the outcomes.

Your Child's Future Can Be Filled With Purpose, True Significance, Power and Confidence

God loves your child unconditionally. He has told His faithful, "For I know the plans I have for you," declares the LORD, "plans to prosper you and not to harm you, plans to give you hope and a future." (Jeremiah 29:11) What can possibly stand in the way of a student who has the blessing of God, parents and school family - coupled with knowledge, wisdom and power to change the world? And that power is virtually limitless. <u>Yes</u>, even in this uncertain world in which we live!

- Your child will learn to think in totally unique and powerful ways that frankly, most people do not even know exist.
